BUSINESS PLAN

Each year immediately following the Club's Annual General Meeting, a workshop is held at which all ideas are canvassed to advance the running and performance of the football club. The ideas and actions are categorised into Football, Administration and Management issues and have resulted in thirteen key areas.

VISION

The Vision is the reason for the Club's existence.

St George AFC's Vision is:

"St George AFC will be the focal point for the growth and development of AFL in the Sydney South region."

CORE VALUE PROPOSITION

The **Core Value Proposition** is what differentiates the St George Dragons from other Sydney AFC clubs. This CVP is the emphasis on **PEOPLE**, from the development of our members as players and citizens, our reliance on supporters, our treatment of visitors, our support for officials and the involvement of the community.

MISSION

St George's Mission is:

- Develop, foster, manage and provide leadership for AFL stakeholders throughout the Sydney South region; (**People**);
- Establish close relationships with all AFL organisations within the region providing assistance to develop the game; (**Organisations**);
- Provide an AFL facility which is identified as the headquarters of AFL within the Sydney South region including the necessary administrative infrastructure; (**Facilities and Administration**); and
- Create and maintain a financially responsible organisation. (**Finances**).





CLUB HISTORY

St George AFC founded in 1928, is steeped in history in many areas of the game. From its humble beginnings, through depression of 1930's and WW2 and through other past theatres of economic and social experiences, St George in 2011, is still regarded as one of the 'Premier Clubs' in the SFL.

Achievements on a Club and personal basis have been many and varied. From winning five First Grade premierships; seven Reserve Grade and 17 Third Grade premierships, there have been many individual medal winners and leading goal kickers in all three grades. There have been disappointments of many Grand Final losses in all grades along with the heart ache of not playing in a final series.

Many players and officials have achieved Life Membership of St George. Bob Sterling who is still very active in the club was inducted into the Sydney AFL Hall of Fame in 2010. Graham (Danny) Dwyer is our No 1 Ticket Holder. Two other notable members, Bob McConnell and Syd Felstead, also achieved Life Membership of NSW AFL, for their contribution not only to St George, but what they gave for the development of Australian Rules throughout Sydney and NSW.

St George is a Club very proud of its junior competition, which it strongly promotes. Over the decades many junior players have become very successful, senior players.

St George players have been drafted into successful AFL careers; the likes of Mark (The Fridge) Roberts, Nick (that goal) Davis, achieving the ultimate of AFL premiership success. Many other former players have played at higher levels in the AFL and throughout Australia. They include Graham Cornes, Aaron Rogers and Dylan Addison. Robbie Ahmat and Craig O'Brien continued their careers with St George after playing in the AFL competition.

Some former players have represented Australia at the highest levels in Cricket (Steve Rixon) and Rugby Union (Laurie Monaghan) and other national sports. Other former players are carving our successful coaching and business careers in locations throughout Australia.

FUTURE OF THE CLUB

Around 2008, after a number of successful years, the last ten or so associated with the Adelaide AFC and known as the St George Crows, the club decided to go in a new direction.

This new direction was based on three main principles:

1. A return to the area's tradition in all sports of wearing the red & white and being known as the St George Dragons. Importantly, this means relying on the youth of our area coming from a stronger relationship with all the junior AFL clubs in our region;
2. A commitment to improving and strengthening the off-field managerial and administrative functions of the club; and
3. Building upon the club's reputation as the "family club" and using as a key differentiator a focus on the people side in all of our actions.

We have seen the formation of a Red & White sub-committee and have had several successful re-union functions. This tradition will continue this year with both a Reunion Dinner and a Return to St George Day at Olds Park. This year will also see the addition of both a club track pants and club jacket to the suite of St George clothing.

The off-field activities have been re-organised. The club has been awarded Silver Level in the AFL's Quality Club Programme, the first senior club in NSW to attain this level. We have also received Level 1 accreditation in the Good Sports Programme an initiative of the NSW State Government.

And now to the football. It is our stated aim to be in a position to challenge for the Sydney AFL Premier Grade flag by the end of the 2013 season. We have seen the junior players re-instate our Under 18 reputation to one of great success having been in the final's series for the last 2 years with one appearance in the Grand Final. These players are now infiltrating their way up through the grades. And now we have the coaches and the coaching panel.

To supplement the football, with the help of the NSW State Government, the Hurstville Council and Sydney AFL, the Olds Park dressing rooms will be expanded and refurbished. We have a major drive to raise \$100,000 over the next 2 years for the St George AFC Building Fund to complete this work.

Following this the ground at Olds Park will be upgraded with the surface removed and replaced and with the lighting upgraded.

All of this is only possible with the help of our major sponsors Presfast and the St George Masos and our No 1 ticket holder Graham "Danny" Dwyer.

If we continue to be honest with our feedback to all, continually seek to improve training standards & seek to uphold the values of players and strengthen attitudes we can create a legacy for years to come.

Real leadership is a constant model that always changes.



PLAYER RESPONSIBILITIES

Pre- Match

- Players are to advise Kevin Wilsen &/or game day team manager in Kevin's absence upon arrival.
- Players are to advise the Coach immediately &/or several hours before should they be running late.
- Players are to arrive 90 mins before game commencement. No Excuses
- Players are to perform warm up together - individual warm up is to be approved by Coach
- Every attempt must be made NOT to bring other players into match day drama - should you be missing something i.e. socks/short etc. sought it out!
- Respect the individual player pre-game schedule, should they wish to seek quite space/time DO NOT BOTHER THEM

After Match

On completion of all home & away games, all players will be required to complete:

- Ice bath recovery.
- Shower
- Have something to eat - Sandwiches will be supplied at all games
- Re-hydrate with light refreshments - medical staff will confirm.
- Players are not permitted to drink alcohol during cool down &/or recovery.

Recovery Session - Next Day

- Recovery session is mandatory for all players and will be under the direction of the medical staff & carried out by the leadership group.
- Should you not able to attend your direct contact in the leadership group must first be notified the day before.

Training & Game Day What To Bring

- Football Boots for wet weather & dry
- Game day shorts home & away
- 2 pairs of socks
- Runners –joggers
- Training Tops & shorts
- Swimming Shorts





- Towel
- Mouth Guard
- Protein drink
- Garbage bag for wet clothes
- Play book
- Commitment for 90 to 120 minutes
- Professionalism

Match Day

Dress- All players (selected and not) required to wear the club polo shirt, club track pants and joggers. Any jacket must be the club jacket with club cap optional.

Locker Room- Only players, coaches and Executive Committee members, and support staff allowed in rooms (unless invited)

Address- Only your coach or nominated player to speak to the team before, at breaks and directly after the match. All others, despite best intentions will be asked to leave.

After Match- On completion of a game, all players will be required for cool down of 15 minutes. This will include light refreshments and stretching.

No alcohol.

Wet Weather Policy

Training will commence 6:30pm sharp every Tuesday & Thursday at Olds Park, Peakhurst rain, hail or shine (unless advised otherwise).

Team Selection

Team selections are held straight after Thursday night training. It is expected that all players attend as a team meeting will be held here. There will be a Pasta night after Thursday training before all home matches. A gold coin donation is expected.

After Match

Home Games- It is compulsory to attend all after match presentations.





Away Games- If invited, it is expected that all players have one drink at the oppositions club (preferably sports drink/water). At all times we must demonstrate we are gracious to our opposition in defeat and in victory.

Mobile Phones

Phones will be **off** in the locker rooms, at training, game day and when addressed by coach/committee.

Injury & Treatment Procedures

All injuries are to be reported immediately to minimise the time spent away from the game. It is the players' responsibility to ensure that all treatments & rehab programmes are carried out according to the directions of medical staff.

1. At Practice:

ANY injury incurred during training must be reported to the senior coach or any of the coaching panel **BEFORE** leaving the ground.

2. In Matches:

ANY injury incurred during a match must be reported to the senior coach, medical staff or any of the coaching panel at the end of a match **Treatment**

Mouthguards

Mouthguards are compulsory and are to be worn in all matches. The insurance company will not be responsible for the payment of accounts for injuries caused through the non-wearing of mouth guards at either practice or matches.

Private Health Cover

It is highly recommended that all players cover themselves with a Private Health Fund.

Please read the Insurance Provisions in this Handbook

Anti-Drug Policy

No recreational drugs of any kind are to be taken by a player to be under the influence during training, match day or any club function. Performance enhancing drugs as described by Australian **Sports Drug** Agency are strictly banned. www.asda.org.au/

The committee has the right to expel any from the club immediately without notice.





Alcohol

It is accepted that you may have a drink or two after training on a Thursday night.

The club discourages binge drinking at official or after match functions. It is expected that all players conduct themselves in a sensible manner at all times.

Random tests will be conducted on match day. Any player with any alcohol in system will be automatically dropped and face the disciplinary committee.

It is recommended after a match you eat and have sports drink/water. During the evening it is advisable to drink light beer or if you have a mixer do so in a middy glass and alternate with glass of water. This will help recovery and prepare you for the week ahead.

Players and supporters who are under the legal age to consume alcohol will not be served or allowed to consume alcohol. This will be strictly enforced with disciplinary action taken if this policy is broken. The cost for younger members of the club to attend club functions will be lower to recognise this.

Smoking

All areas of the Olds Park club rooms are a smoke free zone. No smoking at training, in locker rooms, (home and away games) match day or at any time you are wearing the club uniform. This includes committee, players, support staff and supporters

Our Ground

If you must use the toilet during training or during a game, notify coach and go promptly to toilet. Do not urinate on our ground! Respect it at all times.

St George Juniors

The club expects that you will spend some time with the junior clubs in the region, preferably your own if you come from the area. This help can be in the form of coaching, managing, attending functions and/or presentation nights and similar.

Respect

Show respect for all aspects of the St George Football Club. This includes our sponsors, volunteers, fellow players and coaching and support staff. Remember, you are representing the St George Football Club as well as yourself, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week





- All rubbish and tape is to be placed in one of the many bins provided. Do not leave it where you find it, especially in the showers after the game. We do not have paid staff to clean up after you.
- Drink bottles must be placed in the containers after you have used them. You are not to throw a drink bottle down for somebody else to pick it up. You are not to throw a drink bottle at a trainer.
- No spitting on the club room floors
- When you have finished with the club jumper after a game put it in the jumper bag. You are not to stand on it after a shower and not show the jumper respect.
- When talking with supporters, be patient with their views.
- Do not embarrass the club by negative interaction with the crowd during a game, tempting as it may be.
- Umpires are to be shown respect at all times

Confidentiality and Unity

From time to time you may disagree with an opinion of the club, your team mates or coaching staff and officials. It is specifically encouraged that you discuss this disagreement with the person concerned and even if no agreement on a view can be reached agree to disagree and follow club rules. However, when speaking with anybody outside of the club during your time at St George show a united and positive attitude. We must never give our opposition any basis for thinking that we are any but a united club. Keep club matters in house.

Club Assistance

From time to time you may be asked to assist with certain tasks such as canteen duty or preparation of the ground for play (banners, goal post pads etc). Please co-operate in a respectful way. We are a club of volunteers.

Club Functions

You are expected to attend all club functions such as Pre-Season Launch, the Reunion Dinner and the End of Year Presentations





Sponsors

A list of our generous sponsors will be placed on the notice board. While you need to shop around for the best price and conditions for yourself, you are asked to consider using the club sponsors as a way of paying back their support of you.

Information

It is the players' responsibility to know what is happening within the club, at training and on game day. Make sure you pay attention to what is being said by the coaches and support staff. Ensure that you read the two notice boards within the club rooms. Make sure that you visit the club web site, and check the players' info page regularly. Ensure that you check your email regularly. Or, phone the club coaches and officials if in any doubt about what is required of you.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules – the rules of your Club and the laws of the game.
- Attend training sessions and matches at times advised by the Club. If unable, for a valid reason to do so, players will inform the Club as soon, as is practical.
- Act respectfully toward the officials and players of their own and opposing Clubs.
- Respect and follow the directions of coaching staff, match and club officials.
- Treat all players with respect, as you would want them to treat you.
- Act respectfully towards match officials at all times. Abusive language is unacceptable.
- Avoid individual or collective behaviour, which may reasonably be held by spectators to be offensive.
- Avoid all acts likely to incite spectators to violence or disorder.
- Make no detrimental statements in public (radio, television, print or electronic media) in respect to the performance of any match officials, players, or any policy decisions of the Club or the AFL Sydney.
- Abide by the By-Laws, (Rules & Regulations) and the Competition Rules of the AFL Sydney.
- Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing Clubs.
- Do not use remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability as many such comments are politically incorrect and it is your coach, team-mates, Club and family that are let down with such remarks.



INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Part of your Registration Fee is used to pay for compulsory insurance required by the Sydney/ACT AFL Commission to be taken out by this Club as part of its obligations to take part in the Sydney AFL competition. This insurance is taken out with JLT Sports under an Australian Football National Risk Protection Program. You can see details of this Program at www.jltsport.com.au/afl

This club has Bronze Level insurance. This provides benefits for Capital Benefits and for Non Medicare Medical Benefits. **There is no coverage for Loss of Income.** If you so wish the club can arrange coverage for each individual for this coverage but an additional premium to be paid by the individual will be incurred.

Non Medicare Medical Benefits cover reimburses expenses that are not standard Medicare items and were incurred within twelve (12) calendar months of you sustaining an injury and paid by you for treatment certified necessary by a legally qualified medical physician. This cover includes the cost of medical supplies and ambulance hire.

The Health Insurance Act (Cth) 1973 *does not* permit the Trustee or Insurer to contribute to any charges covered by Medicare (including the Medicare Gap). This means that any charges for treatment from a Doctor, Surgeon, Anaesthetist or Surgeon's Assistant are not covered. It also means charges for X-Ray, some MRI Scans (if Medicare registered) and Public Hospitals are not covered. In addition, there will be no refund in respect of:

1. any expenses recoverable by you from any other insurance scheme or plan providing medical or similar coverage or from any other source except for the excess of the amount recoverable from such other policies/plans. or
2. any expense to which the National Health Act (Cth) 1953 or any of the regulations made there under apply.

Under this insurance coverage, you cannot claim for any Medicare gap. Under the bronze level, you are limited to 50% rebate for any item with \$100 excess and a maximum of \$2000 per claim. There is no cover for loss of income. You are strongly advised to take out your own private insurance. You should note that you cannot claim under this insurance scheme for any rebate under you private medical insurance.

Should you be injured and wish to make a claim under this scheme you have 180 days from the date of the injury to lodge your claim. You should see the Club Secretary for help with this. **It is strongly recommended that you have Private Medical and Hospital Insurance.**
